
Dear Eamonn,


The agreement between this organisation and RTE dated 24th October 2008 will expire on the 31st December 2009.

To enable negotiations conclude on a fresh agreement, we propose that the terms of our agreement of 24th October 2008 be extended on an interim basis for a further period of 1 month from 1st January 2010 to 31st January 2010. This interim extension shall be without prejudice and without precedent to any terms which may be concluded in negotiations between us, and retroactively adjustable in the light of any concluded agreement between us or order of the Controller.

For the avoidance of doubt the RTE Diaspora service will be covered under this interim extension, again without prejudice and without precedent to any terms which may be concluded in negotiations between us.
